Privacy policy

This policy is provided under the EU Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR), for those who consult the website www.stefanovillani.it. Please note that this policy applies only to Stefano Villani's website and not to other web addresses that may be consulted by the user through link.

Treatment owner

The "owner" of the processing of data, relating to identified or identifiable persons who access and browse this site, is Stefano Villani, address Via Maestro Zanagnolo, 28 – 25065 Lumezzane (Brescia), Italy.

Legal basis for treatment

The processing of personal data by Stefano Villani is based on consent – under art. 6, par. 1, lett. a) of the EU Regulation 2016/679 – expressed by you through the navigation on this website and its consultation, thus accepting this information. Consent is optional and can be revoked at any time by email to stefanosteck@icloud.com, stating that, in the absence of consent, certain services and navigation on the website may be compromised.

The processing of personal data is necessary for the pursuit of the legitimate interest of the controller for the purpose of providing information about the activity of Stefano Villani, under art. 6, par. 1, lett. f) of the EU Regulation 2016/679, in accordance with the same Regulation.

Processed data and treatment purposes

Browsing data – Access to this site and the navigation within it is done through the use of a web browser. Some data needed for internet browsing, by its very nature, could allow users to be identified through processing and associations with data held by third parties. In particular, it refers to the IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users connecting to this site, the Uniform Resource Identifier (URI) notation addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, etc. This data is used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information about the use of the site and to check its proper functioning and is deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used for any liability in the event of cybercrime related to this site. The data for those who have submitted requests to Stefano Villani by telematics using the tools on this site are kept for no more than seven days, however for the time it takes to submit the answers and for any needs of investigation of crimes by the Judicial Authority.

Data voluntarily provided by the user – The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mail to the addresses indicated on this site involves the acquisition of the sender's address, which is necessary for responses, as well as any other personal data contained in the message. This data is processed to respond to sent messages and to fulfill any related requests. Failure to provide personal data for communications with Stefano Villani or to send any requests prevents it from being processed. The data is stored for the period strictly necessary for the purposes for which they are processed.

Cookies – Recommendation on indicated (No. 2/2001) defines cookies as “a computer recording of information transmitted from a web server to a user’s computer for future identification of that computer at the time of future visits to the same website”. Cookies (small text files that the visited site sends to your device, where they are then stored in order to be retransmitted to the same site at the next visit) can be permanent or sessional, “*First party*” or “*Third-party*”.

Permanent cookies consist of a text file sent from a web server to a web browser and, once stored by the browser, remains valid until the scheduled expiration date (unless it is deleted by the visitor before that date). Session cookies expire at the end of the usage session, that is, when the web browser is closed. In accordance with the requirements of the Personal Data Protection Authority's Measure of 8 May 2014, No. 229 (published in the G.U. – General Series of 3/6/2014, no. 126) and the document “Clarifications on the implementation of the implementation of the implementation of the cookie policy”, informs you that this site uses the following types of cookies:

- *session cookies* (which are not stored persistently on the user's computer and vanish with the closing of the browser) and are strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) required to enable safe and efficient site navigation. The so-name session cookies used on this site avoid the use of other computer techniques that may be detrimental to the confidentiality of the user's browsing and do not allow the acquisition of personal identifying data of the user.
- “*Google Analytics*” *third-party session and permanent cookies* for site usage monitoring and statistics. These cookies do not collect information that can identify you in any way. Information generated anonymously in relation to the site is used to report on the site's usage.
- *third-party cookies* for sharing pages and/or articles that make it easier to access social networks and social tools on the internet. Such cookies are: Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn.

All cookies are not used for profiling and tracking, but only for the functional purposes described above and their installation does not require the user's consent. Security measures
